- 1. Have an egg and spoon race! Hard boil enough eggs for each member of your family. Decorate the eggs with paint, stickers, feathers... what ever you can find. Set out a race course and ready, set, RACE!
- 2. Make Easter nests: Recipe attached.
- 3. Make an Easter garland. Cut card / paper into an Easter egg shape. Decorate each egg, hole punch and then thread onto a piece of string or similar.





### Chocolate Easter Egg Nest Cakes


#### Ingredients

- 225g/8oz plain chocolate, broken into pieces
- 2 tbsp golden syrup
- 50g/2oz butter
- 75g/2¾oz cornflakes
- 36 mini chocolate eggs

#### Method

- 1. Line a 12-hole fairy cake tin with paper cases.
- 2. Melt the chocolate, golden syrup and butter in a bowl set over a saucepan of gently simmering water (do not let the base of the bowl touch the water). Stir the mixture until smooth.
- 3. Remove the bowl from the heat and gently stir in the cornflakes until all of the cereal is coated in the chocolate.
- 4. Divide the mixture between the paper cases and press 3 chocolate eggs into the centre of each nest. Chill in the fridge for 1 hour, or until completely set.


